

ABSTRACT:

Architecture and building technologies are experimenting strong changes.  BANSENSHUKAI OR THE NINJA STRATEGY APPLIED TO THE LEADERSHIP OF THE 21ST CENTURY (subject studied also in the most prestigious schools of the world) (9:30-11:30)

Bansenshûkai ("Ten thousand rivers meet in the sea"), written by the master strategist Fujibayashi Yasukate in 1676, is the most extensive and revered compilation of all of those that collect the shinobi tradition of feudal Japan. Kept secret until the 20th century, it deals with the strategic principles of military ninja intelligence.

The pragmatic and flexible techniques he transmits, as opposed to the poetic and difficult to interpret language of Tsun Tzu's Chinese manual "The Art of War", as well as his defense of the principles of subtle action as opposed to the use of Violence and the strength of other comparable historical treaties has made it a leading text for 21st century business, political and social leaders. The shinobi strategy, based on observation, analysis, perseverance and dissimulation is absolutely traditional and completely new in the times of tribulation that we live.
